Lord Mayor's Charitable Foundation inspires and encourages accessible philanthropy by enabling donors to establish and build Charitable Fund Accounts to support positive and sustainable social change.

What are the benefits of a Charitable Fund Account?

Charitable Fund Accounts are an invaluable tool to assist parents to foster in their children philanthropic values, financial responsibility, increase social awareness and inspire future generations. In addition, donations made to a Charitable Fund Account are tax deductible and the income is tax exempt.

These Terms set out the ways that you may be involved with your Charitable Fund Account and how we will recognise your generosity.

We may amend these Terms from time to time; for example, to reflect changes in the law or to the Foundation's granting practices. You can access these Terms on our website at Imcf.org.au.

The terms 'Charitable Fund Account holder', 'you' and 'your' refer to the Charitable Fund Account holder's named in the Charitable Fund Account Establishment Form.

I. WHAT IS A CHARITABLE FUND ACCOUNT?

A Charitable Fund Account is a management account of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund (ABN: 63 635 798 473), a public ancillary fund with Deductible Gift Recipient status.

We will apply your initial donation, any further donations, and any investment income (the Property) towards your Charitable Fund Account and will account for it separately in our internal financial reporting. We will hold the capital of your Charitable Fund Account in perpetuity and make grants of income each year to eligible charities within your chosen impact areas and areas of interest.

2. HOW MUCH DO I NEED TO DONATE TO ESTABLISH A CHARITABLE FUND ACCOUNT?

Option 1: Initial donation of less than \$10,000

You have the option of establishing a Charitable Fund Account with an initial donation of \$2,000 or more, and then building it up to \$10,000 over time (e.g. a minimum of \$1,000 per year over 8 years).

Option 2: Initial donation of \$10,000 or more

You can establish a fully-fledged Charitable Fund Account with an initial donation of \$10,000 or more.

Further donations

We encourage you to make regular donations via our online donation portal which provides a quick, easy and secure way of contributing to your fund.

3. HOW WILL THE FOUNDATION MANAGE AND INVEST THE PROPERTY?

We will invest the Property in accordance with our investment policy, ethical investment policy and the provisions of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Foundation Act 2017 (Vic).

Our investment policy is reviewed annually by the Foundation's Board and Investment Committee. The Investment Committee meets regularly and includes experienced finance and investment professionals.

The nature of the tax-deductible status of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund means that your donations, once made, become the property of the Foundation and cannot be refunded.

The Property will form part of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund and does not form a separate fund or trust. This means that the Property will not be separately accounted for in the public statutory financial statements of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund;

4. WHAT IS THE FOUNDATION'S PROCESS FOR MAKING GRANTS?

Crants decisions are made by the Foundation

All decisions about grants from Charitable Fund Accounts are approved by the Board following a due diligence process. When making grants, the Foundation selects organisations and projects based on our up to date know-how and extensive research into the current issues facing Melbourne and Victoria and shared learning with internal and external experts and community partners. The Foundation is committed to granting to projects which can demonstrate quality outcomes that can maximize their impact through: good governance, solid leadership, strong strategy, with a focus on improved sustainable outcomes for the communities in which they operate.

Through this process, the Foundation is well-positioned to match your philanthropic objectives with suitable projects. We encourage you to contact the Foundation to discuss your philanthropic goals and, if relevant, to explore collaborative granting opportunities with the Foundation.

In making grants, we will consider the Impact Areas and particular areas of interest that you have indicated on this form to make your philanthropic vision a reality.

The management of donor requests in accordance with the paragraphs below is necessary for any donations to be tax deductible, where the Charitable Fund Account is tax deductible:

- (a) The Foundation is not required to respond to any request or donor direction for a grant to be made to a particular not for profit organisation;
- (b) The Foundation may invite the donor to make requests or indicate preferences at certain times but the Foundation is not required to invite the donor:
- (c) The Foundation may make grants from the funds from the donor's gifts along with other money in the Fund without first advising the donor or seeking a request.



Only Eligible Charities may receive grants

We will grant the Property to Eligible Charities, being organisations that are endorsed by the ATO as both:

- A. Tax Concession Charities, and
- B. DGR Item 1 (Deductible Gift Recipient).
- C. Charities that are eligible but for their connection with government.

We will not make a grant unless we are satisfied that an Eligible Charity is reputable, is not in or at risk of being placed in receivership or at risk of revocation to their registration as an Australian Charity, or deductible gift registration endorsement, and/or charity tax concessions and that making the grant is consistent with our duties under Australian laws.

Exclusions

The Foundation cannot provide retrospective funding, nor can it make grants to:

- Organisations that are not Australian registered charities, established or carried on within Victoria
- · Clinical research projects
- · Endowment funds
- Recurrent expenditure where there is no plan in place for the long-term sustainability of the project or program
- Auspicing the organisation recommended must be the one undertaking the program or project.

We grant a minimum amount each year

Each financial year, we determine a total amount to be distributed from the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund (the Fund Distribution).

The Public Ancillary Fund Guidelines 2011 require the Foundation to distribute at least 4% of the net value of the Lord Mayor's Charitable Fund each financial year.

We attribute to your Charitable Fund Account an amount available for granting, based on the Fund Distribution and less any administration fees (the Granting Allocation).

The Foundation's policy is to distribute the Granting Allocation in full each financial year.

We apply a portion of grants to your Impact Areas

The Foundation's granting and strategic initiatives are focused on tackling the most important community needs – captured within our Impact Areas.

To learn more about the impact the Foundation has had in each of these areas and the organisations who need our support, visit **Imcf.org.au**. As the needs of the community change, we adjust the Impact Areas to continue to address key issues within our community.

We encourage you to nominate the Impact Areas that best reflect your philanthropic goals.

Charitable Fund Accounts with balances of less than \$10.000

If the balance of your Charitable Fund Account is less than \$10,000 at 30 June of the previous year, you may express a preference that the Granting Allocation be returned to capital, rather than distributed, for a maximum of five years or until your Charitable Fund Account reaches a balance of \$10,000 (whichever occurs first).

5. WHAT INFORMATION AND RECEIPTS WILL I RECEIVE?

The Foundation will provide you with an annual statement on the investments, administration fees and grants attributed to your Charitable Fund Account.

We will issue tax deductible receipts for the value of your initial donation, and any additional donations.



6. WHAT IS THE ANNUAL ADMINISTRATION FEE?

The Foundation charges minimal fees to strike a balance between the Foundation's commitment to accessible and cost-effective philanthropy and ensuring the ongoing sustainability of the organisation.

The Foundation's current annual administration fees are based on the capital balance of a Charitable Fund Account at 30 June the previous year.

There is no fee to establish the Charitable Fund Account. The annual administration fee assists the Foundation to operate efficiently and effectively, ensuring fiscal responsibility in grant due diligence, donor education, research, reporting and compliance and other activities.

Fees are set by the Foundation's Board, who may decide to vary our administration fee over time to reflect increases to the costs of managing your Charitable Fund Account.

7. CAN I NOMINATE ADDITIONAL CONTACTS?

We will consider your requests to allow one or two representatives, such as family members, to:

- access statements about your Charitable Fund Account and receive information about the Foundation and its events, and/or
- assume the role of Charitable Fund Account holder in nominating preferences where no Charitable Fund Account holder remains involved (for example, due to death or incapacity).

We may ask additional contacts to acknowledge these Terms before expressing granting preferences.

8. WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHARITABLE FUND ACCOUNT FALLS DORMANT?

We may consider your Charitable Fund Account to be dormant if:

- we have not had contact with you, or a person nominated by you, for a period of five years or more; or
- the balance of your Charitable Fund Account is less than \$10,000 and you have made donations of less than \$1,000 over the last five years.

If your Charitable Fund Account falls dormant, we will continue to honour your generosity and ensure your donations have a lasting impact. We will make grants based on your philanthropic goals.

9. CAN I FUNDRAISE FOR MY CHARITABLE FUND ACCOUNT?

Yes. The Foundation allows donors to produce published and electronic material on Charitable Fund Accounts to aid in attracting funding and donations. However, our prior written authorisation is required.

When marketing a Charitable Fund Account it is important that you first consult with the Foundation and understand your legal obligations. Any fundraising activities you conduct must comply with our Fundraising Guidelines and not be misleading as to the control or the activities of the Charitable Fund Account.

All public references to your Charitable Fund Account should indicate that it is 'a Charitable Fund Account of Lord Mayor's Charitable Foundation'.

10. CAN I USE THE FOUNDATION'S NAME AND LOGO?

Please contact the Foundation to seek approval prior to printing and distribution of any public materials containing the Foundation's logo or wording about the Foundation in relation to your Charitable Fund Account.

11. PRIVACY


The information you provide is used to establish and manage your Charitable Fund Account, and for other purposes set out in our Privacy Policy, available at Imcf.org.au/privacy.
